Free barebones

1-2 weeks set up
Installation and hosting.

basic

3-5 weeks set up
Columbia domain set up, installation and initial configuration of software, and incorporation of existing logo and preferred color palette.

Custom Quote simple

7-8 weeks set up
Basic support plus a color palette consultation, support for building user roles within the journal software, and basic training.

simple + design

7-8+ weeks set up
Simple support with an emphasis on design services. There is an initial fee for build and one mock-up, and an hourly fee for design work thereafter.

extended

11-13 weeks set up
Installation, domain set up, support for site layout and configuration, design consultation on integration of graphical elements, and extensive training.

premier

17+ weeks set up
Comprehensive set up, configuration, training, and visual support, including logo design based on two rounds of feedback. Multiple layout options, incorporation of complex graphical elements, and more.

Blog > For blog set up, please add on one week for free support levels, three for extended, and five for premier.

Wiki > For wiki set up, please tack on one week for free support levels, and two for extended. A wiki is already included in the premier service.
