## Submit, share, and preserve your dissertation

As a doctoral student, completing your dissertation is the pinnacle of your graduate career. With the electronic submission system, it is easier than ever to submit your dissertation. In addition, your dissertation will be deposited in Academic Commons, Columbia's online repository.

### Academic Commons provides many benefits for your dissertation:

- Your dissertation will receive its own distinct permanent URL and a robust metadata page — a distinctive presentation of your crowning scholarly achievement.
- Your ideas are **secured** by making them available here first.
- Your work will have readers beyond your dissertation advisers, **such as potential publishers**, and will impact future research.
- You can add your dissertation's link to your CV for easy access for future employers.
- Your file is safe. The Libraries have a long-term commitment to guaranteeing safe data storage and coping with changes to technology.
- The permanent link allows you to share your dissertation on other sites and people online via new media tools (e.g., Twitter).

### Other Benefits of Electronic Submission

**REDUCED FEE:** The GSAS submission fee has been reduced to \$85.

**NO PRINTING:** Because you've submitted your dissertation electronically, there is no need to print two hard copies, as students have done in previous years.

**FAST TURNAROUND:** Your dissertation will appear quickly and will be accepted on a rolling basis.
